GOLD SPONSOR \$5,000 or more Actual case examples of what your money might buy

- Help 3 households (two female head of households with 5 children, and one senior couple) who are choosing between rent and food and rent and unexpected medical bills to help them stay in their home and stop eviction proceedings
- 20 hours of financial education training to help these households build a spending and savings plan
- 10 hours of Client Advocate services by a certified geriatric care manager or RN Care manager for 4 seniors to identify new resources and benefits to allow them continued safety and independence to remain at home
- Improve home safety through the purchase and installation of safety grab bars, fire extinguishers and a battery-powered smoke detector for 4 fixed income seniors who have fallen or are at risk for falls.

SILVER SPONSOR \$2,500 Actual case examples of what your money might buy

- Connect three veterans with resources through the Veterans Administration and pay their rent for two months because they lost a part-time job, their only source of income
- 15 hours of financial education and Benefits Check-Up reports to help 3 fixed income seniors stop the worry of not having enough money to last to the end of the month
- Six hours of Client Advocate services provided by the geriatric Care Manager or RN Care Manager to partner and work with social services to jointly develop a self-sufficiency plan for three senior who lost a spouse.
- Conduct a home safety and nursing assessment for three shut-in to understand their risks for falls and install safety grab bars in their bathrooms

COPPER SPONSOR \$1,500 Actual case examples of what your money might buy

- Partner three volunteers to donate 30 hours of time per month to transport three isolated seniors to the grocery store, the bank and the pharmacy so that they can stay healthy and remain safe at home
- Six hours of Client Advocate services provided by the geriatric Care Manager or RN Care Manager to develop an emergency plan when three seniors can no longer remember if they turned the stove off after cooking or paid all the monthly bills
- 15 hours of financial education and Benefits Check-Up reports to help 3 fixed income women cope with recent widowhood and help stop the worry of not having enough money to last to the end of the month
- Pay one month of rental assistance and turn back on the utilities because two senior women had to choose between rent and prescriptions

BRONZE SPONSOR \$1,000 Actual case examples of what your money might buy

- Rental and utility assistance for two families living under one roof to prevent homelessness
- 10 hours of financial stability training to learn to save and build financial goals to become self sufficient
- New winter coats and new clothing for six children who are wearing their older brother's or sister's clothes
- A gift basket of food for a fixed income senior choosing between rent and food;

FRIENDS OF GVAS \$500 Actual case examples of what your money might buy

- \$50 gas cards to help five displaced workers get to job interviews.
- Transport one isolated senior to her doctor in Tucson
